### Notes to editors

1. MIB is the fund of last resort operating in all jurisdictions in the UK where the motorist responsible for an accident either had no insurance or failed to stop
2. In addition the Bureau operates the Green Card System and is the Compensation Body under the 4<sup>th</sup> EU Directive
3. MIB manages the Motor Insurance Database, which contains details of all registered vehicles in the UK. Currently there are over 34 million records on MID
4. Check if the vehicle you drive is on MID by visiting [www.askmid.com](http://www.askmid.com)
5. Commercial Policy holders should speak to their insurance provider for advice and guidance about getting vehicle data onto MID
6. Private policy holders should always contact their insurance provider if there are any errors or discrepancies in insurance documents
7. The police target uninsured hotspots and they use the MID to identify vehicles that may be uninsured. The police can seize any vehicles they have reasonable suspicion of being uninsured
8. If a vehicle is not on MID the police may stop that vehicle
